## Sussex/Lisbon Senior Shuttle



The Sussex Lisbon Senior Shuttle is a safe, reliable, efficient affordable transportation option offered to the seniors in our community. Shuttle routes are semi-fixed, meaning that pick-up and drop-off locations are routine. However, if you do not live near one of the designated pickup locations, it may be possible for you to ride the shuttle. Contact the Sussex Community Center at 262.246.6447 for more information.

One ticket is for a round-trip shuttle ride (with the exception of the Brookfield Square Mall trip which requires two tickets). Tickets can be purchased at the Sussex Community Center, W240N5765 Maple Ave. or Sussex Village Hall, N64W23760 Main St., \$3 each or 10 tickets for \$25. Each shuttle ticket must have the shuttle rider's *first & last name* legibly printed on it; or place a return address label on each ticket when you purchase them. **Why?** It is important for the shuttle driver to know who is currently riding the shuttle and in the event of an emergency.

**Would you like to have lunch?** The meal-site program is available each day the shuttle is in service. *Call the Sussex meal-site 24-hours in-advance at 262.246.6747 between 9:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Any other time during business hours and prior to 1:00 p.m. call 262.548.7848 (ADRC) to make lunch reservations.*

### Food Pantry Visit

## Waukesha County - The Ride Line

The Waukesha County Ride Line is available to Waukesha Co. residents 65 years of age or older. Transportation priorities are: medical, nutrition, work-related, social & respite. The Ride Line is available 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. M-F at a cost of \$1 each way for meal-site programs. Other fares are determined by origin, destination & ability to pay. Riders must make reservations at least 1 - 2 days in advance of need. Door to door service with a handicapped accessible van.
