

## **Sussex Recreation Department** **Scholarship Program**

The Village of Sussex does not want to exclude any child from the Recreation Department programs because of financial need. Parents who feel they are unable to afford the fees for a program, due to unemployment, illness, or hardships, should complete a scholarship application and submit it to the Recreation Department located at the Sussex Community Center (W240 N5765 Maple Ave). Scholarship application forms are available at: the Sussex Community Center, the Sussex-area Outreach Services, the Sussex Village Hall, the Village website [www.village.sussex.wi.us](http://www.village.sussex.wi.us), and the Hamilton School District Guidance Offices.

The Sussex Recreation Department scholarships are for children 18 years and younger. The scholarships will cover 100% of the cost of six programs per child per year. The maximum contribution per program is \$75. The funding will only cover programs run directly through the Sussex Park and Recreation Department. The children must reside in the Village of Sussex. The scholarship will be good until the end of the calendar year.

To apply for a scholarship, the parent or guardian of the child must fill out a Scholarship Application Form and provide proof of residency. Forms must be dropped off or mailed to the Sussex Community Center. Staff will review the application, and reply within 10 business days, once the application is received. When registering for a program, "sch" should be listed in the fee section of the form to indicate that the scholarship money will be used for the listed program.
